

A Simpler, Humbler, and Bolder Church¹

Dear Members and Friends of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin,

It is time for your congregation's annual meeting! This is a great opportunity to reflect on the past year of faithful ministry. Now is the time to ask the BIG questions! How were we faithful in ministry? How were we faithful in participating in God's simple mission to love our neighbor? Now is the time to celebrate how God's Spirit has inspired your ministry! Give thanks to God and celebrate for the good that your congregation has accomplished!

Now is also the time to tell the truth about your ministry. How has your congregation fallen short and not been faithful to God's will? Lacked energy, a sense of purpose or mission? Now is the time to humbly tell the truth if your congregation has lost its focus or has little energy for God's work.

We all need to take an honest look in the rear-view mirror of the last year and ask how have we been faithful and how have we failed to be faithful to our baptismal promises. Then we can boldly move into the New Year 2024 asking how we can with God's help do better.

The Church of England took a long look into the rear-view mirror and with much prayer has discerned that moving forward they will strive to be a Simpler, Humbler and Bolder Church in the future. The Church of England described their vision for the future in this way:

Simpler, humbler, bolder are virtues we believe God is calling from us at this point in our history. They run through the vision and shape all we do and all that we are.

- **Simpler** because we are not as big a church as we used to be
- **Humbler** because we are facing our failures, and this is not easy.
- **Bolder** because the love of Christ compels us. We have a gospel to proclaim, and we live and minister in a world of much pain and confusion.

I believe these three virtues could also help us in the coming year. I invite your councils and leaders to lean into these questions in 2024:

1. **Simpler:** How can we simplify our structure so more time and energy can be spent on loving our neighbors and joining in God's mission in our community? How can we focus on what is really important and let go of the trivial or unnecessary?
2. **Humbler:** What isn't working? How have we fallen short? We can't do everything we use to do so what ONE thing can we do for Jesus? How can we work with other churches, denominations in our community?
3. **Bolder:** How can your congregation be braver and bolder in sharing the good news about Jesus in a hurting world? In prophetic witness to justice issues in our world? In working for right relationships with our neighbors and all of creation?

Friends, I am truly grateful for your partnership in the gospel and all the ways you are faithful in ministry.

I invite you to move joyfully, simply, humbly and boldly into God's future in 2024.



Pastor Judy's Message



Dear Members of Little Elk Creek,

Thank-you for making 2023 a good year at Little Elk Creek. I am proud of us! We are not “rolling in dough” but we are paying our bills and doing good ministry in the name of Jesus. I am grateful to God and to this congregation for many things this year. I love that Sunday school is going well and that more children and adults are getting involved. It so wonderful that the grandmothers of this church stepped in and would not let Sunday School die. (Of course, it is not just grandmothers, but they have taken a leadership role.) I heard one of them call it the “granny brigade.” This made me smile. Oftentimes,

parents “retire” from helping with Sunday school when their children are no longer in it. I am grateful to the women who saw a need and stepped in, even though their children are grown-up. Children are dear to us and especially dear to Jesus. It is essential that they learn about Him! I am also grateful every time a child stays for worship and comes up for children’s sermon. I love that they are growing in faith and learning to praise God in the sanctuary. I appreciate how supportive this congregation is of our youth. You have always been supportive of confirmation and youth trip fundraisers. Recently the Little Elk Creek Women donated \$500 to help with our summer trip to the National Youth Gathering! The church council pledged to help with expenses for one of our chaperones. I am deeply grateful. I have really enjoyed working with church council this year—they are fun and kind. We are blessed with good leaders.

Worship is also a cause for rejoicing this year. Our average worship attendance is up from 35 last year to 46 this year! We have not returned to pre-Covid numbers, but we are doing better. Keep up the good work! We are fed and strengthened for serving Jesus in the world when we get together in God’s house. Worship has been wonderful this year. The choir, cantors, and soloists have been great, and the organist is excellent. I am grateful to the ushers, altar guild, acolytes and everyone else who makes worship happen. I am also grateful to all the people who help maintain the building and the property so we have a safe and comfortable place to gather. There are people who cut the grass, take the cans to be recycled, shovel, plow and do so many other things and do not ask for compensation or recognition. We are blessed. Speaking of blessed, Eldon Hilson, are handyman, usher captain, and all-around guy who gets stuff done at church, is recovering well after his heart attack. I cannot imagine running this church without Eldon. I am grateful God answered our prayers for his speedy recovery. I have also enjoyed working with Dianne this year. She is an excellent parish secretary and she makes my job easier and more fun.

We know Jesus meets us in worship because He said He is with us wherever 2 or 3 are gathered in his name. We get to meet Jesus’ face to face whenever we help someone who is hurting. Jesus said that whenever we help “the least of these,” we help Him. We are called to feed the hungry, welcome strangers, and visit those who are lonely. I was thinking that we don’t do that enough at Little Elk Creek. The women of LEC make quilts and school kits to send overseas and all of us help the church donate to good causes that help people who are suffering, but we don’t do much where we have face to face interactions with people in need. I was wondering how to change that and then I heard that the church women had volunteered to prepare and serve a meal once a month at Stepping Stones. This is wonderful!!! I am going to help in February. Men and youth are encouraged to volunteer also. I know it is going to be a good experience.

My church goals for 2024 are that we continue to improve attendance, we find more ways to interact with people in need, and we have a Bible study that includes men and women.

Thank-you to all of you who make it a joy to serve here! Every time you send a card, let me know about something we are doing that helps you or you volunteer at church, it warms my heart. You are all in my prayers.

Worship included blessing the backpacks for the new school year. Bibles were handed out to the 3rd graders and older children who need a bible. Following worship, a delicious lunch was served featuring Chad's Flip-flop Chicken and other picnic food and activities for the children was held. Regular Sunday School began September 25th. We have two age groups for the children, a preschool age class and elementary age class. There are about 6 preschool children and 7 elementary age children. Our average attendance is 10 children. - Card and napkin sales.
- We had another successful Thrift Sale and Bake Sale in March.
- Purchased 2 Easter lilies for Easter Sunday.
- Beautiful flowers were planted in the front brick planter at church.
- Some members attended the Retreat at Luther Park in June.
- Served the Ludington Band Concert in August. It is a very good fundraiser for us and great fellowship with the community.
- Enjoyed Garden Parties all summer.
- We had a float in the Downsville Days Parade which featured the LEC Church Basement Ladies.
- Quilted every Wednesday during the fall and winter months from 9:00 am to 2:30 pm. - We had a successful Church Fall Supper in October. Donations from our church members were very generous. Thank you to all that worked at the supper or helped in anyway.
- Annual Christmas Tea was held Sunday December 3rd. The theme was, “Go With God!”
- Christmas Baking Day at church was Saturday, December 9th. The cookies made that day or baked at home were sold at the Bake Sale following the Sunday School Christmas Program / Church Service on December 10th. Proceeds went to the NHLEC Youth Group - 2024 National Youth Convention.
- Purchased 2 poinsettias in honor of Christmas for the church altar.
- We held a special meeting in December to discuss volunteering at Cairn House – Stepping Stones of Dunn County. We committed to serving a meal once a month in 2024.
- Thank you to the Thrivent members of our church that applied for Thrivent Community Impact Cards to help purchase supplies for are many projects.
