To the amazing disciples of the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin,

I remember with gratitude preparing for annual meetings when I was most recently a pastor at St. John's Lutheran in Bloomer. So many reports to collect, so many people to recruit, so many meetings to plan - it was a busy time indeed! But in doing all of that work, they all came together for two important purposes:

1. To share God's stories through your ministries.
2. To plan future God stories through your ministries!

When you really think about it, annual meetings are a time to celebrate what has already happened and a way to dream about what could be in the forthcoming months and years! And from my new perspective as your bishop, I love knowing that despite all of the great things we share in common, there are so many contextual things that are happening in your congregation alone. What a blessing as we come together as fellow ELCA Lutherans, yet all distinct and unique in what God is calling us to do!

As you may know, we also share in our ministry together as the Northwest Synod of WI. There are several things to celebrate that I want to share here.

1. We continue to financially support our synod youth and their related ministries, such as our bible camps and youth gatherings.
2. We raised over \$120k for our friends in Malawi to build additional solar powered wells, despite having a goal of \$40k! It was so fun to share that information with them in person when Deacon Laura and I visited a few months ago and got to see firsthand some wells that had been built and purchased from this synod in the past.
3. We support our young adults in campus ministry, along with other young adult opportunities, such as our upcoming young adult gathering in Puerto Rico this January. This is such an important part of life as they explore their faith and make it their own and we get to help nurture those conversations!
4. We are helping our first call pastors lean into their leadership and nurture their God-given gifts as they discover the joys and opportunities of their first call experiences. This includes helping them out financially as they seek to reduce their educational debt that they bring into that first call.

Finally, I want to thank you for electing me as your bishop. Thus far, I have felt the full support of this synod as I visit congregations from week to week. The days of the election itself, along with the installation in September, have both been two of the most meaningful and life changing experiences of my life and your support is a significant part of it I have fully enjoyed visiting each congregation and look forward to seeing yours over the course of my six-year tenure. Yes, I realize it will take four years to get to them all, but the way the time has been flying, it won't be long!

Please know that your synod staff are here for you and want to accompany you on your journey of faith. We will continue to pray for us all in our lives together to make sure that our relationship with you is supported and upheld in prayer, in both the joys and struggles of ministry. We want our relationships to be intentional and strong so that you never feel isolated in this work. We are grateful for your partnership in the gospel!

LEC Council President's Report

The year of 2024 has been challenging in a number of ways. Update on information on Little Elk Creek Steeple, Lightning Protection, Interior balcony ceiling. An insurance claim for the roof damage, wind & hail, on May 5th 2020 with Church Mutual. Church Mutual did an appraisal on May 30, 2023. Replacement value was \$150,694.15, Actual cash value awarded of \$127,432.27. Copy of insurance actual cash value statement is listed on the next page. Paid BA Roofing a down payment for steeple roof, base flashing, 50% lightning protection and gutters. The amount was \$56569.67, on September 21, 2023. This was with Church Mutual money. BA Roofing didn't come back to do the work on the above projects. I sent letters to Blake Anders of BA Roofing for return of down payment on February 7, 2024, February 20, 2024 requesting the down payment be refunded. I received no reply to the letters. I filed a report with Dunn County Sheriff's Officer, James Gates. James talked to Blake Anders with no results in the matter. LEC Council members did negotiations with Blake Anders by phone & texts. He agreed to issue a check if we come to Woodbury, MN to pick it up. This check was for \$44,21.67 August 29, 024. This check came back -NSF. A replacement check came to LEC mail box September 3, 2024 for \$42,427.25 this check cleared the bank. We will be filing a small claims case with Dunn County Clerk of Courts for the difference between the initial check and the check that cleared. The rain gutters have been completed, \$7,100.00. by Titan Rain Gutters. Projects to complete yet are the Lightning Protection \$22,150.00, Balcony ceiling, \$1700.00 and Steeple roof-base flashing.

2024 Little Elk Creek Grounds Trustee Report

During the 2024 calendar year, it was my role to look after the lawn and related matters. I purchased a new riding mower which helped with the process, mowing weekly from early spring until late fall. Weed-n-feed was applied to the north side lawn including around the sign and flagpole. Also, the weeds grew around the building and curbs much more than in the past. I sprayed some weed killer and then scraped the weeds that were taking over the curbs. Removing the weeds really helped the aesthetic appearance of the building, which is really beautifully constructed I might add. Every month throughout the spring/summer/fall I made a trip to the recycling center with aluminum cans in the LEC fenced storage area and returned checks made out to the church to be deposited to the General Fund. One issue with the aluminum cans, and probably non-members doing it, was that people think it's okay to stuff cans into cardboard 12 or 30-pack containers to be taken to recycling. This caused me to remove the cans from that large bag, then remove the cardboard. At least 25 times this summer this took about 30-40 minutes and was really messy, plus sometimes a mouse would jump out. FUN! All in all, it was a good year for the lawn and I learned that a little bit of weed-n-feed can keep the weeds from overgrowth in 2025. (Also helped a bit with the gutter project in 2024 & working on the steeple project in 2025)
